Admission Requirements

STPM

A pass at the STPM level with a minimum of Grade Point of 2.00 in any TWO (2) subjects and a pass in Mathematics and English at SPM level;

Note: The requirement for a PASS in Mathematics and English at the SPM level can be excluded if the candidate obtained a credit or higher grade at STPM.

A LEVEL

A pass A-Level with a minimum of Gred D in any TWO (2) subjects, and a pass in Mathematics and English at SPM level;

MARICULATION

A pass at the Matriculation level, or Foundation or Pre-university with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 from an institution recognized by the Malaysian Government;

STAM

A pass at the Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) level with a minimum of Grade Jayyid and a pass in Mathematics and English at SPM level;

Note: The requirement for PASS in Mathematics and English at the SPM level can be excluded if the candidate obtained a credit or higher grade at STAM.

UEC

A pass at the UEC level with minimum of grade B in FIVE (5) subjects including a pass in Mathematics & English;

DIPLOMA

A Diploma with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 from universities/colleges recognized by the Malaysian Government;

IB

A pass at the International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma level with minimum score of 30 points;

OTHERS
