This foundation programme is specifically designed for full time students preparing for undergraduate studies at UNIRAZAK. Students with SPM or O-Level or equivalent qualifications are required to complete 50 credits to enroll in the degree programmes. CFS and UNIRAZAK will equip students new to university life with the necessary skills and knowledge to navigate their chosen programmes. These include interpersonal and communication skills, as well as analytical and quantitative abilities, to

enable students to work effectively in a team for group assignments and related activities. Regardless of whether they are local or overseas students, all will find their pre-university experience rewarding, enriching and enlightening at UNIRAZAK.

UNIRAZAK'S Foundation in Arts programme is a one-year preparatory course for school-leavers who wish to pursue a Bachelor's degree in business, government and education. This programme covers a basic knowledge of fields such as management, economics, information and communication technology, language and global studies.

In the foundation year, students will gain exposure to these areas via hybrid learning through a mix of lectures, tutorials, group work and activities on UROX (the UNIRAZAK online experience platform). Students may then continue at UNIRAZAK by pursuing a Bachelor's degree programme.

A pass at the Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) level with minimum of 5 credits; **OR**

O LEVEL

A pass at the O-Level with at least Grade C in Five (5) subjects; **OR**

UEC

Pass Unified Examination Certificate (UEC) with minimum of Grade B in any **THREE (3)** subjects;

OTHERS

Other equivalent qualifications recognized by Malaysian Government

INTERNATIONAL

- A minimum score of Band 4.0 in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS)*; **OR**
- A minimum score of 450 for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)
