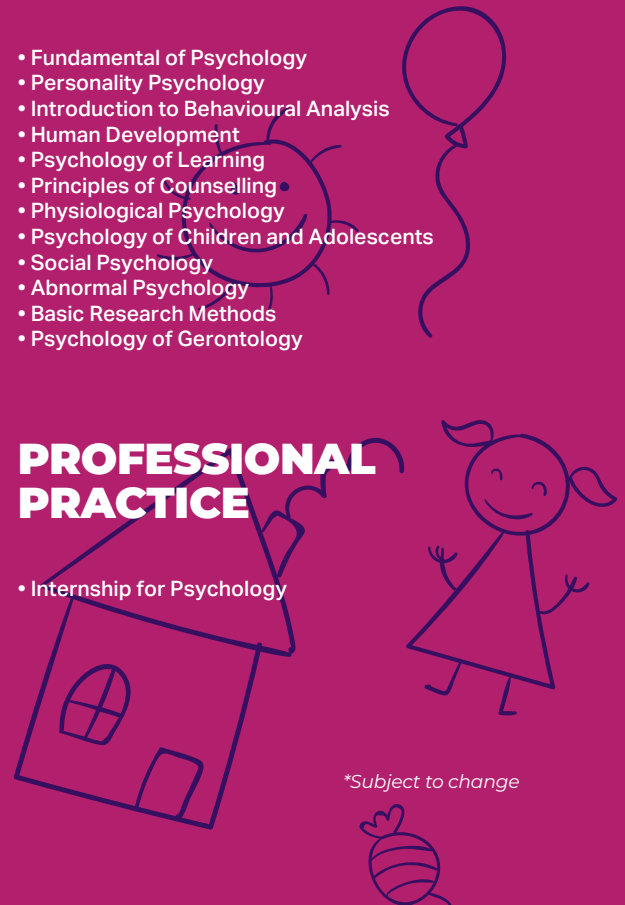

Admission Requirements

SPM

Possess Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) with a minimum of THREE (3) credits in any subject and a pass in Mathematics and Biology/ Physics/ Chemistry/ General Science/ Applied Science*; **OR**

STPM

A pass in Sijil Tinggi Persekolahan Malaysia (STPM) with a minimum of Grade C (GP 2.00) in any subject and a pass in Mathematics and Biology/ Physics/ Chemistry/ General Science/ Applied Science*; at SPM level; **OR**

STAM

A pass in Sijil Tinggi Agama Malaysia (STAM) with a minimum grade of Maqbul and a pass in Mathematics and Biology/ Physics/ Chemistry/ General Science/ Applied Science at SPM level; **OR**

SKM

A pass in SKM Level 3, MQF in the relevant fields (Note: The HEPs are required to conduct screening and provide appropriate bridging courses in Mathematics and Biology/ Physics/ Chemistry/ General Science/ Applied Science); **OR**

OTHERS

- A Certificate (Level 3, MQF) in the relevant fields with at least CGPA of 2.00 and a pass in Mathematics and Biology/ Physics/ Chemistry/ General Science/ Applied Science at SPM level; **OR**
- Other relevant equivalent qualifications recognised by Malaysian government as equal to the above requirements.
- Possess an Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning (APEL A) for admission.

INTERNATIONAL

- A minimum score of Band 4.0 in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS)*; **OR**
- A minimum score of 30-31 for an Internet Based Total (iBFT) for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)*; **OR**
- A minimum score of 5 for TOEFL Essentials (online); **OR**
- A minimum score of Low B1 (140) in Linguaskill Test; **OR**
- A minimum score of 36 in Pearson Test of English (PTE); **OR**
- A minimum score of B1 (140) in Cambridge English Qualifications and Tests; **OR**
- A minimum score Band 3 in Malaysian University English Test (MUET); **OR**
- Successful attainment of B1 (140) in CEFR aligned exams by Cambridge English Qualification conducted by the Centre for Continuing Education (CCE).
