Admission Requirements



- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.50 as acceptedby the HEP Senate;
 OR
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 and not meeting CGPA of 2.50 can be accepted, subject to a rigorous internal assessment; OR
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the HEP Senate and with relevant working experience, subject to a rigorous internal assessment; OR
- A Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) in non-related fields with a minimum CGPA of 2.00 as accepted by the HEP Senate and without relevant working experience, subject to passing pre-requisite courses; OR

OTHERS

- Other equivalent/related qualifications to a Bachelor's degree (Level 6, MQF) recognised by the Malaysian Government.
- · Admission through Accreditation of Prior Experiential Learning or APEL.

INTERNATIONAL

- A minimum score of Band 6 in the International English Language Testing System (IELTS)*; OR
- A minimum score of 60 for an Internet Based Total (iBFT) for the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL)*;
 OR
- A minimum score of 8.5 for TOEFL Essentials (online); OR
- A minimum score of 59 in Pearson Test of English (PTE); OR
- A minimum score of Mid B2 (169) in Cambridge English Qualifications and Tests; OR
- Band 4 in Malaysian University English Test (MUET); OR
- Successful attainment of Mid B2 (169) in CEFR aligned exams by Cambridge English Qualification conducted by the Centre for Continuing Education (CCE).








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
